

RoHS Restriction of Hazardous Substances

Danfoss Compressors GmbH is committed to be compliant with the requirements of Directive 2002/95/EC on the restriction of use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. The enforcement date of the Directive is 1st of July 2006.

But Danfoss Compressors GmbH has proactively been modifying the product programme, so that this aligns with the Directive already from 1st of July 2005.

The following type of parts have been modified:

- Screws
- Brackets
- Terminal connections
- Parts of compressor mountings (sleeve, washer, clip, pin, nut and screw)



As e.g. Cr⁶⁺ passivation (goldchrome) has been changed into Cr³⁺ passivation and salt fog tests made acc. to DIN50021 to ensure minimum same lifetime (hours to rust) as before. This change in surface treatment can be seen as a change in colour from "golden" into "silver". With the products now being compliant with Directive 2002/95/EC the packaging of our products has been provided with a label as shown left indicating the compliance with the RoHS Directive.

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
